

Dear Membership,

The Wayne M. Hall Advanced Analysis Scholarship Award provides two \$10,000 scholarship awards to deserving analysts. Notification of the 2d Annual competition was sent out by Fort Huachuca in October. Only one command responded by nominating an individual.

The Military Intelligence Corps Association (MICA) and BG (Retired) Wayne M. Hall have elected to extend the period of time for analysts to compete for the award and to modify the participation process, eliminating the command nomination requirement.

We are asking the membership to encourage analysts that they know and work with to participate. The scholarship is designed to be used by awardees to further their advanced education in analysis subjects. The timeline for the scholarship process is as follows:

- Have those analysts interested notify the MICA Executive Director by the end of the day 9 December of their intent to compete for the Wayne M. Hall scholarship award. We request applicants reply electronically. The Executive Director can be reached at execdir@micorps.org. Have the applicants provide the following information:
 - A mailing address (for delivery of materials)
 - Phone number
 - EMAIL Address
- Once we receive an intent statement we will send to the applicant the book “Intelligence Analysis – How to Think in Complex Environments”. We will give each applicant 30 days to from the time of receipt to complete the following tasks:
 - Read “Intelligence Analysis – How to Think in Complex Environments”.
 - Compose an essay of not less than five pages and not more than ten pages on the concepts and theories of Advanced Analysis contained in “Intelligence Analysis – How to Think in Complex Environments”.
 - Prepare a seven to ten page PowerPoint presentation detailing how you would brief your leadership on the concepts and theories of Advanced Analysis contained in “Intelligence Analysis – How to Think in Complex Environments”
 - Submit papers and presentations electronically to MICA’s Executive Director at execdir@micorps.org.

Once we have all the participants' inputs the Scholarship Committee will begin its deliberations. We have scheduled fifteen days for the board to review and render its decision. We expect to make award announcements toward the end January 2012.
